### **WilloWind - Linfairn Wind Farm**

I am writing on behalf of WilloWind Energy Ltd to advise of plans to resume consultation on our proposed Linfairn Wind Farm, which will be located on land south of Straiton and south east of Maybole in South Ayrshire.

In September 2013, the company made an application to the Scottish Government under Section 36 of the Electricity Act to build a 25 turbine wind farm with a site capacity of 62.5 MW.

Since then we have restructured our Scottish operations and carried out a full review of a number of our planned projects. One of these is the Linfairn Wind Farm proposal. Over the last two months this has involved meeting with key stakeholders and taking their view on the project and their experience of working with WilloWind to date.

I am now leading the Scottish operations, and have been visiting WilloWind's potential wind farm sites and ascertaining the next steps for each project with our appointed consultants.

Following feedback and discussions with statutory consultees and local communities and taking account of the potential environmental impacts, WilloWind is now looking at a reduced scheme of up to 19 turbines with the northern leg of six turbines closest to the village of Straiton removed. WilloWind is now committed to reconsulting on the remaining southern leg.

We are working towards submitting an addendum to the Section 36 application to document the changes and their implications, details of which will be made available in due course.
